The Freehold Township Heritage Society is proud to announce the addition of the Heritage Arts Pavilion to the Oakley Farm Museum historic site. Located at 189b Wemrock Road in Freehold Township N.J. the Pavilion has been designed to include architectural elements from the Oakley Farmhouse located on the property.

The Heritage Arts Pavilion will feature programs of a diverse nature throughout the Summer and Autumn months. Programs such as historical, theatrical, musical and others will find a welcome home under the Pavilion. The Heritage Society executive board has undertaken this project to help increase the visibility of the Oakley Farmhouse and surrounding buildings. The site includes an agricultural equipment display, blacksmith shop, a toll house and other outbuildings that feature antique artifacts on display. The Oakley house and out buildings are open to the public for tours at various times during the year.

Historically based programming during the 2017 inaugural season at the Pavilion have been partially funded by re-grant funding from the Monmouth County Historic Commission. The F.T Heritage Society hopes

that the Pavilion will become a community wide location for performance oriented organizations and groups. The Pavilion' design, unique location and design make it a perfect place for creative individuals to showcase their talent.

A celebratory ribbon cutting will take place on July 13, 2017 at 1:30pm followed by a historical performance of WWI songs by Linda Russell and Company. The group will perform humorous songs, marching tunes, love songs and laments. The Pavilion is an outdoor venue and visitors are urged to bring a lawn chair or blanket for their seating comfort. All performances are free to the public.
