TOWNSHIP MEETING DATE – September 6, 2022

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF BLOCK 112, LOT 1 LOCATED AT 55 SILOAM ROAD AND BLOCK 91, LOT 45 LOCATED AT 120 TURKEY SWAMP ROAD REAR, IN THE TOWNSHIP OF FREEHOLD

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Freehold, County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey as follows:

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12-5 the Township is authorized to acquire real property; and

WHEREAS, the Township has determined it to be in the public interest to purchase Block 112, Lot 1 located at 55 Siloam Road and Block 91, Lot 45 located at 120 Turkey Swamp Road Rear in the Township of Freehold (hereafter “the Properties”), for open space or other public purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Township has negotiated with the property owner who owns both of the Properties, and has agreed to purchase the Properties for \$70,000.00 contingent upon title review and receipt of funds to purchase the Properties by bond, loan or grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the Mayor and Township Clerk of the Township of Freehold are hereby authorized to execute a contract for the purchase of the Properties, such purchase price to be in the amount of \$70,000.00.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Mayor, Township Clerk, Township Attorney and such other municipal officials as are necessary, are hereby authorized to undertake any and all acts reasonably necessary to effectuate the purchase of the above-described Properties.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication according to law.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT:

This Ordinance authorizes the purchase of Block 112, Lot 1 located at 55 Siloam Road, and Block 91, Lot 45 located at 120 Turkey Swamp Road Rear in the Township of Freehold.

WHEREAS, the Monmouth County Board of County Commissioners has approved an Open Space Trust Fund and established a Municipal Open Space Program to provide program Grant funds in connection with municipal acquisition of lands for County park, recreation, conservation and farmland preservation purposes, as well as for County recreation and conservation development and maintenance purposes; and,

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Township of Freehold desires to obtain County Open Space Trust Funds in the amount of \$190,000.00 to fund a pedestrian trail bridge at Michael J. Tighe Park, located at 65 Georgia Road, in Freehold Township, NJ (Block 84, Lots 4.34, 6.01, 7, 16, 18, 20, 21.01, 22, 23, 24 and 25); and,

WHEREAS, the total cost of the project, including all matching funds is \$458,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, the Township of Freehold is the owner of and controls the project site;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Freehold Township Committee that:

1. Peter R. Valesi, Township Administrator, or his successor is authorized to (a) make application to the County of Monmouth for Open Space Trust Funds, (b) provide additional application information and furnish such documents as may be required for the Municipal Open Space Grants Program and (c) act as the municipal contact person and correspondent of the above named municipality; and

2. The Township of Freehold is committed to this project and will provide the balance of funding necessary to complete the project as described in the Grant Application in the form of non-county matching funds as required in the Policy and Procedures Manual for the Program; and
3. If the County of Monmouth determines that the application is complete and in conformance with the Monmouth County Municipal Open Space Program and the Policies and Procedures Manual for the Municipal Grants Program adopted hereto, the Municipality is willing to use the approved Open Space Trust Funds in accordance with such policies and procedures, and applicable Federal, State, and Local Government rules, regulations and statutes thereto; and
4. Peter R. Valesi, Township Administrator, or his successor is hereby authorized to sign and execute any required documents, agreements and amendments thereto with the County of Monmouth for the approved Open Space Trust Funds; and
5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

TITLE: RESOLUTION APPROVING WIRELESS COMMUNICATION FACILITIES MODIFICATION APPLICATION FOR CROWN CASTLE ON BEHALF OF AT&T, 3417 ROUTE 9 NORTH (APPROXIMATELY 1/2 MILE NORTH OF THE INTERSECTION OF ROUTE 9 AND ELTON ADELPHIA ROAD), BLOCK 80, LOT 8, APPLICATION NO. WCFMA 12-22

- - - R E S O L U T I O N - - -

WHEREAS, Crown Castle on behalf of AT&T (the "Applicant") has filed a Wireless Communication Facilities Modification Application dated June 21, 2022, together with plans prepared by B&T Group, 1717 South Boulder Avenue, Tulsa, Oklahoma, 74119, dated May 5, 2022 (collectively, the "Application"), assigned Application No. WCFMA 12-22, in order to make the following modifications to the existing monopole: removal of nine existing AT&T antennas and replace with twelve new antennas, removal of three remote radio head (RRH) units and replace with six new units, relocation of three existing RRH units, removal of nine tower mounted amplifiers, installation of AT&T squid and associated DC and fiber cables, and installation of structural tower mounting modifications; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant has also proposed to make the following modifications to the ground facility: removal of three existing interior mounted RRH units, fifteen diplexers, four GSM cabinets, one UMTS cabinet, one 24V power plant, seven 24V rectifiers and one battery string, installation of one 48V DC power plant, two 48-24V DC converters, eleven 48V DC rectifiers, one 48V battery rack, five 48V battery strings and other associated equipment within existing equipment racks; and

WHEREAS, by memorandum dated August 8, 2022 from the Assistant Township Engineer to the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Freehold, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, the Assistant Township Engineer advised of no objection to the approval of the Application; and
