WHEREAS, a Contract was awarded to Black Rock Enterprises, LLC by Resolution R-20-80 on March 24, 2020 for the 2020 Pavement Overlay Program and FY 2020 Municipal Aid Program (MA-2020-Stonehurst Boulevard Phase I-00673) in the amount of \$3,992,452.89; and,

WHEREAS, the Township's Professional Engineer, T&M Associates, by letter dated December 23, 2020 and the Township Engineer, by memorandum dated December 28, 2020, recommend reduction Change Order No. 1 in the amount of -\$474,865.67 due to an increase in some contract quantities and a decrease in other contract quantities, bringing the total contract amount to \$3,517,587.22 and has advised that the above-referenced project has been completed; and,

WHEREAS, Black Rock Enterprises, LLC has submitted a one-year Maintenance Bond in accordance with the terms of the bid specifications; and,

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Township Committee of the Township of Freehold to adopt the within Resolution only for the purposes described in N.J.S.A. 2A:44-132;
